OLD BUSINESS

The volume of recycle being collected is a continual issue and cost to the Township.

The committee recommends that a hand out be drafted for at the waste sites.

The hand out is to include;

The need to compact recycle crush cans and plastics

Breaking down cardboard to make it flat will be mandatory

Include cost for shipping to explain need for compaction

Include any changes to the approved recyclable materials

It has been requested that the recycling contract be brought to the next meeting to investigate what materials are listed for pickup.

Issues brought to attention by James;

1. James requested a shelter that could be moved around the site when the pit is moved. This was not budgeted for this year. It can be brought back to the Committee during budgeting.
2. Logistic issues for shipping when large amounts of recycling come in a day. It had been requested that restrictions be put on the amount of recycle that can come in at a time. The committee feels that this it would be best to continue to encourage the compaction of recycle.

NEW BUSINESS

The Committee has discussed the potential benefits and issues that may arise from the introduction of bag tags at the waste sites for household garbage.

Recommendation to Council

It is recommended that the Township consider going to a bag tag system to prepare for the closure of the sites. The committee would like direction to investigate the cost for tags and what steps would need to be put in place to go forward with this process.

Recommendation to Council

The Committee would like to receive direction from council to examine Waste Disposal Site Fees to ensure that they are relevant to the cost for diversion from our waste sites. The committee would draft an amendment to schedule "C" of Bylaw 2013-20, any changes made would be drafted to take effect in January of 2020
