OLD BUSINESS

Bag Tags

- The committee would like to have a report drafted that reviews the changes to the amount of litter and illegal dumping in a are with the introduction of bag tags.
- Gather information from neighboring municipalities that are using bag tags on the benefits and drawbacks to incorporating this system of management.

Hours of Operation

- Committee members have been receiving feedback from residents in the Municipality that they are un happy with the scheduling of the Millbridge and Grimsthorpe sites. They would like to see the Millbridge site open on the Saturday and the Grimsthorpe site open on the Sunday.
- Those opposed to the current scheduling may request a delegation at an upcoming meeting of council to voice their concerns.

Tipping Fees

- The committee members will take the current tipping fees home for review and comment, to be brought back at the next meeting of the committee.
- The committee would like to collect input from the Waste Site Attendants on the matter.

NEW BUSINESS

Compactor

- The township received a surplus compactor from Hastings County earlier this year
- The compactor is to be transported to the Millbridge site to be set up under the existing roof structure.
- The intent will be to bring the compactor into commission spring 2020, there will need to be a review of the job description and the logistics to incorporate this. (Where will they sort the material, where will they store the compacted material, how much time will this take, will there be additional hazards involved in sorting the materials)

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Cameras at Sites

- There are issues with the installation of cameras at the sites with regards to clear pictures that can be useful to fine those people dropping materials at the gates outside of hours

New Discussions arising during the meeting to be brought back at the next meeting;

- Propane tanks are being dropped at the site outside of hours (there are approx. 12 to date)
- Review the Littering fines for the township.
- Littering Signs need to be erected around the municipality with the set fines for littering
- The members of the committee would like to see the enforcement of the compaction of materials, such as set bundle sizes for cardboard and the crushing of aluminum cans.
