



Councils for the municipalities in the North Hastings area have been working together to develop a community safety and well-being plan. This plan is in response to a provincial requirement that all Ontario municipalities do this work. By working together, our North Hastings municipalities can do a quicker, cheaper and better job of planning that will benefit everyone living in North Hastings. The province requires that we have this done by January, 2021; but we are guessing that with your help, we will be finished by this time next summer.

The next phase in this process is called “community consultation”. It is based on our belief that the best plan will have the inputs and ideas of as many North Hastings residents as possible. **THIS IS WHERE WE ASK YOU ABOUT WHAT IS MOST IMPORTANT TO YOUR SAFETY AND WELL-BEING IN NORTH HASTINGS.**

The Townships of Tudor and Cashel, Limerick, Wollaston and Faraday are hosting a joint community consultation and anyone over the age of 16 is invited to attend. This event will be held on **WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 14, 2019** from **6:00 – 8:00 p.m.** at the **LIMERICK COMMUNITY CENTRE** located at 7645 Highway 620. We will hand out copies of a questionnaire for you to complete. It will consist of five main questions about your community. There will also be 13 multiple-choice questions about you and your background; like where you live, your age, gender identity, and whether you have children; etc. We do this in order to be sure we are hearing from everyone and that the final plan addresses the most important issues for specific groups. All of the information we collect will be anonymous. It should not take any longer than 15 minutes. If you would prefer to complete the survey at home, you can take it with you and once completed, drop it off at any municipal office in the North Hastings area.

In order to include as many people as possible, these surveys will be collected until August 31st, 2019. We hope to have the community consultation information analyzed in the fall at which time we will share the results with you.
