**GILMOUR, ON** – At 3:00 p.m. on April 02, 2020, Reeve Libby Clarke declared a State of Emergency for the Township of Tudor and Cashel. The declaration of an emergency under s. 4. (1) of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act provides the Township with all options available to protect the health and safety of individuals and families living in Tudor and Cashel Township.

“Reeve Libby Clarke stated that having conferred with my fellow Councillors and our senior leadership team, it is my opinion that it is necessary for me as the Reeve, to make this declaration at this time. With evidence of community spread of COVID-19, it has been determined an emergency exists that places our residents at risk. It is imperative to address this serious public health threat. It is essential that we do our part to control the spread of COVID-19. This declaration is in support of the declaration made by the Province of Ontario on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and the County of Hastings on March 26, 2020.”

This declaration implements the emergency plan of the municipality and will help protect the health, safety, well-being and property of residents. This declaration of a State of Emergency is effective immediately and will remain in effect until further notice.

The Township of Tudor and Cashel Emergency Operations Control Group met today and fully supports Reeve Clarke in the declaration as we all need to be taking proactive measures to help flatten the curve on the COVID-19 pandemic.
