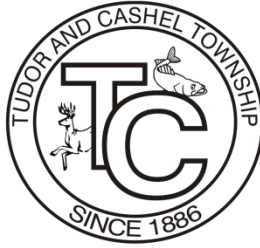

Library

The library is now open for curbside pickup. Call in your order to 613-474-1096 or notify us on our "Gilmour Library" Facebook page. The books, DVD's, etc. are then delivered curbside during library hours (Mon 5-8 p.m. and Wed 4-8 p.m.). Beyond library hours, special request orders can be placed in a bag within a box in the Municipal Office lobby entrance and picked up during regular business hours by appointment.

The Library is continuing to offer **FREE WIFI** access, which many of our local residents and cottagers appreciate. Internet service is not always reliable or available from homes and/or cottages in this area. In addition to that, Gilmour Library is offering the TD Summer Reading Club for kids. This program provides kids with access to 41 e-books in English and 25 in French, online author readings and printable colouring sheets. This program can be accessed from the **FREE WIFI**, which reaches beyond the library building into the parking lot and a little beyond. We are also working on bringing e-books to our patrons if we find there is a demand for that service.

Also, new this year, we are offering a DVD Pool with a seasonal rotation of 60-80 DVD's available for our cottagers and local residents to choose from. This program has had a positive response from our regular patrons.

We hope that the introduction of added services will increase the number of residents and visitors that are making use of this service, we are also looking for additional ways to add value.

We continue to follow Ontario guidelines closely, as well as those of our local Township in preparation for re-opening to the public with full services, as restrictions ease.
