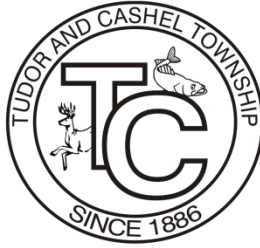

Message from The Mayor And Council

At the council meeting on May 5, 2020 Council passed a resolution to change the Title of Head of Council from Reeve to Mayor and Deputy Reeve to Deputy Mayor. In keeping with the Modernization initiative and in continuity with the rest of Hastings County it is a very positive step.

The change was done partly because the term Reeve is not understood by some people from larger populations and it will help with the Township's seasonal residents. The change will also help when working with government agencies and with business in the private sector, because those agencies have a better understanding of the title Mayor. This change is at no cost to the taxpayer.

Building Department News

Effective May 11, 2020 building departments have become an "essential" service under O.Reg. 209/20 which states permits ***must*** be issued even if the Municipal Office is closed and all time frames associated with the OBC are to be adhered to moving forward. This means that all permits will be issued but only the construction outlined in O.Reg. 82/20 can have inspections. To clarify this, any new permits issued where the work is being performed by the homeowner can proceed but if the project is being done by a contractor they can only go as far as needing a footing inspection. Further to that, any permit that was issued before April 4th will be getting all inspections as well.
