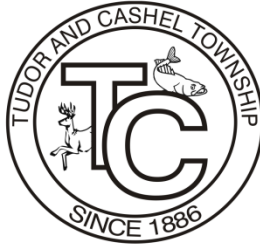

#### **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**

The Municipality of Tudor and Cashel is seeking volunteer applications for the newly forming Finance and Asset Management Committees. The municipality is seeking committee members that are reflective and inclusive of residents from the Municipality. The volunteer positions will begin December 2020 or January 2021. The scheduling of meetings has not been defined at this time but the frequency will adhere to Procedural Bylaw 2020-40 which was passed Nov. 3, 2020. Interested candidates must submit a letter of interest which includes their experience, background, or expertise in finances and/or asset management. These attributes will be essential in meeting the mandate of this committee. The Committee will be formed of an appointed member of Council, the Treasurer or their designate and four eligible volunteers from the public. Letters of interest will be received by the Clerk from November 20, 2020 until December 3, 2020 at 11:00 am.

The Finance and Asset Management Committee will provide recommendations to Council, in cooperation with other Boards, Committees and Municipal employees, and champion the long-term asset management and financial plan for the municipality. The Committee will assist in the updating of Tudor and Cashel Township Strategic plan. The Finance and Asset Management Committee will be an advisory based group that will assist in drafting policy and procedures to be adopted by Council. These policies and procedures will guide Council in their decision making with regards to finances.

Council has determined that specific expertise, background, or experience is required to achieve the mandate, and volunteers will be selected in accordance to this.
