FIRE INFORMATION/EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT-HYDRO APP FOR CELL PHONES

Smoke alarms are mandatory on every floor of your residence and outside sleeping areas. Carbon monoxide alarms are also mandatory. The Township has **FREE** Smoke Detectors available on a first come first serve basis.

There is no day burning allowed within the Township from April 01 to October 31 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. After this time, should you wish to burn, please ensure that the size of your burn pile is no bigger than 2m x 2m x 2m. Please also ensure you have proper equipment and individuals to control the fire. Before you start a fire, please check the municipal website or office to ensure there is no fire ban in place that would prevent any burning.

You can download the free Hydro One App on your cell phone to know when the hydro outages are occurring in your area and to know when the hydro is expected to come back on.

TAX PAYMENTS

You can now receive your Tax Notice by email. If you are interested in having your Tax Notice emailed to you, please contact the office. admin@tudorandcashel.com. Once you are set up please be sure to check your junk mail folder. We understand that sometimes paying your tax bill in full by the due date may be difficult. If you would like to break your tax payment down into monthly payments, please feel free to do so. If you choose to do this, please be aware that interest will still be charged on the first day of each month for any outstanding balance. You can pay by cash or cheque, or directly through your bank. Payments must be made in Canadian Funds. There is a credit card payment option available through the Township Website, all fees are paid by the user.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The introduction of the bag tags for garbage disposal will start August 1, 2020 - By September 1, 2020 bags will no longer be accepted without a tag at the sites. To receive your initial tags, you **MUST** bring **BOTH** of your dump cards to the WASTE SITE, when tags are given out the cards will be marked. Recycle is still accepted free of charge. Please ensure recycling and garbage are separated properly and placed in the appropriate bins. Recycling keeps our disposal sites from filling up quickly. Please also ensure clear bags are used for your garbage and that cardboard is broken down and bound together not in plastic bags.

Please ensure you purchase a **dog tag** from the office for the 2020 year. The price is \$5.00 for the first tag and \$3.00 for each additional tag.

The Township has implemented the **CodeRED system**. The system sends telephone calls, text messages, and emails to inform residents to better protect life and property. Follow the information card included with your taxes to sign up.
