THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TUDOR AND CASHEL BY-LAW NO.: 2018-06

BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE PARKING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TUDOR AND CASHEL

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 170, under The Highway Traffic Act, no person shall park or stand a vehicle on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic or the clearing of snow from the highway;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 181, under The Highway Traffic Act, no person shall deposit snow or ice on a roadway without permission in writing from the road authority.

WHEREAS Section 27 of the Municipal Act, 2001 permits a municipality to regulate the Traffic and Parking on municipal streets that they have jurisdiction over;

AND WHEREAS Section 63(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, permits a municipality to remove, impound, restrain or immobilize an object or vehicle placed, stopped, standing or parked on a highway in contravention of a by-law that a municipality has passed regarding placing, stopping, standing or parking an object or vehicle on a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Tudor and Cashel deems it desirable and necessary to adopt a Traffic and Parking By-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Tudor and Cashel enacts as follows:

DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this By-Law:

"Park" or "Parking", when prohibited, means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when standing temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers.

"Street" or "Highway" includes a common or public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, designed and intended for, or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles.

"Vehicle" includes a motor vehicle, traction engine, farm tractor, road-building machine and any vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power, but does not include a motorized snow vehicle or the cars of electric or steam railways running only upon rails.

PARKING REGULATIONS

- 1. No person shall park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain parked on any highway so as to obstruct a vehicle in the use of any laneway or driveway;
- 2. No parking allowed which will interfere with normal road maintenance including, but not limited to, snow removal;
- 3. Upon discovery of any vehicle parked or standing in contravention of this bylaw, the appropriate Enforcement Officer may cause it to be moved or taken to

and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for removing, care and storage thereof, if any, will be at the owner's expense; and

4. No snow is to be moved from private property onto Township roads, unless clear of the plowed road width.

ENFORCMENT

- 1. This By-law shall be enforced by the OPP Inspector or designate, the Municipal law Enforcement Officers for the Township of Tudor and Cashel and any other person employed to enforce the rules of this by-law.
- 2. This By-law repeals all previous By-laws and/or Motions of Council pertaining to the same.
