

SCHEDULE "A"
TO BY-LAW 2013-20

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

The following are considered to be Household Hazardous Waste and will NOT be accepted at the Tudor and Cashel Waste Sites. They must be disposed of at a licenced facility designed for that purpose"

1. Batteries (all types)
2. Bleach
3. Drain Cleaner
4. Gasoline mixtures
5. Household cleaners
6. Medication
7. Oil
8. Paint
9. Paint Solvents, turpentine, etc.
10. Pesticides and herbicides
11. Propane and gas cylinders (other than those used for cooking)
12. Used needles, lancets and syringes (must be placed in a sealed plastic bottle, clearly labeled as containing needles – add some bleach to bottle)

OTHER UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

1. Asphalt
2. Biomedical wastes
3. Earth – rock
4. Explosives or combustible material (other than Household Hazardous Waste)
5. Hay or straw
6. Hazardous and Toxic Waste (other than Household Hazardous Waste)
7. Human excrement
8. Motor vehicles
9. PCB related material
10. Radioactive Waste
11. Raw or processed sewage
12. Unknown Waste
13. Waste from other landfill sites, former dumps and waste disposal areas except by special agreement and negotiated costs
14. Fibreglass/wood boats
15. Wood & wood products (examples of wood products: brush, paneling, painted wood, wood siding, plywood leaves, pressure treated lumber, pine needles, untreated lumber, wooden furniture, etc.) NOTE: The Grimsthorpe Site is allowed to burn segregated, clean wood and brush which must be carried out in strict compliance with the Ministry of the Environment Document titled "Guideline C-7, Burning at Landfill Sites" dated April 1994.

MANDATORY RECYCLING LIST

PLASTIC & METAL CONTAINERS

Metal Cans & Foil
Empty aerosol and paint cans

Plastic Containers:

Soft drinks
Detergents
Juice
Bleach
Shampoo
Dairy products
Clear and foam cups, trays and packaging

BOTTLES & JARS

remove caps & lids, rinse
bottles

separate clear & coloured
glass bottles

PAPER FIBERS

Corrugated Cardboard (flattened, no soiled pizza boxes or waxed boxes)
Boxboard and mixed paper:
Cereal boxes
Shoe and detergent boxes
Rinsed milk and juice cartons
Paper bags
Tetra paks
Sugar and flour bags
Cardboard tubes
Books
Egg cartons
Junk mail
Household paper
(no paper towel or tissue)

PLASTIC BAGS

Rinsed milk pouches
Grocery, bread, dry cleaning bags
Frozen vegetable and blue newspaper bags
Outer wrapper from toilet and hand tissues
(no meat, cheese or stretch wrap, cereal box lines or chip bags)

NEWSPAPERS & MAGAZINES

Newspapers
Inserts
Phone books
Magazines, catalogues

PLASTIC OIL & ANTIFREEZE CONTAINERS/PAILS

Containers/pails must be drained	}	Specific bin available at waste disposal site for these items
Prefer to have lids on containers/pails,	}	
but this is not mandatory	}	

Please try to ensure that all aluminum cans, plastic bottles, milk cartons, etc. are crushed.

SCHEDULE "C"

WASTE DISPOSAL SITE FEES

VOLUME	SITE FEES ARE FOR SORTED WASTE DISPOSAL ONLY – UNSORTED WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED
Household garbage only: car, small truck, minivan or truck NO RACKS	Free
Household garbage only: car or truck with trailer no larger than 6' x 8'	Free
Household garbage only: car or truck with trailer larger than 6' x 8'	\$100.00
Construction Material: small truck	\$ 10.00
Construction Material: car and trailer or pick-up truck	\$ 30.00
Construction Material: pick-up truck and trailer no larger than 6' x 8'	\$100.00
Trailer larger than 6' x 8' or if the material is above the box height of pick-up or trailer	\$200.00
Single axle truck larger than a pick-up	\$200.00
Tandem axle truck	\$250.00
Tri-axle truck	\$450.00
Washer, dryer, watertank, metal bathtubs	Free
Sofa/couch, large chair, box spring or mattress	\$ 20.00 per item
TV's new than 2000	\$ 5.00 per item
TV's older than 2000 (picture tube type), microwaves	Not Accepted
Table, chair (metal legs must be removed)	\$ 10.00 per item
Decommissioned (tagged by a licensed person refrigerator, freezer and air conditioner, etc.	\$15.00 per item – Must be tagged
Non-decommissioned (untagged) Freon based units	\$30.00 per item
NOTE: Some white goods/refrigeration equipment is subject to environmental regulations and restrictions. These will only be accepted at the Waste Site if all laws and regulations permit! All white goods must have lids and doors removed! Barrels must have lids removed. Those that cannot be reused must be cut in half lengthwise. NO EXCEPTIONS.	
Tires: No tires with rims accepted	Free
Small household appliances: toasters, lawn chairs, food processors, kettles, etc. (MUST be placed in scrap metal pile)	Free
All construction waste must be separated prior to coming into the waste site. Example: Clean fill, clean wood (no paint or plaster), drywall, plastic plumbing, vinyl siding, insulation, painted, stained or finished coated wood products, etc., all electrical copper/aluminum wire, pipes or other metals. Contact Ministry of Environment for disposal of asbestos contaminated material and contaminated soils.	

Receipts must be given for all fees paid.

Note: Any payments over \$50.00 must be made by cheque payable to The Township of Tudor and Cashel.
