OLD BUSINESS

1. Bag Tags

Council has directed the committee to move forward with the introduction of Bag tags for household garbage.

New Waste Site cards will be going out with the Interim billing in February. It is suggested that the initial free tags would be given out at the sites by attendants upon presentation of the new waste site pass. An information pamphlet will be included with the tags.

The program will be scheduled to roll out May 15th, 2020.

An SOP will need to be drafted for money handling.

There are approximately 1230 property owners in the township.

Printing fees for tags are 10,000 @ \$504.00 as quoted by Hannolitho Bancroft
It will cost approx. \$2,100.00 to print off 40,000 tags.

2. Tipping Fees

Minor changes to schedule "C" to be sent to council for approval.

Included reference to REG.347-General Waste Management to accommodate concerns about Biomedical waste.

3. Councilor Bridger is going to investigate the cost to purchase game camera/security cameras for waste sites.
