The minutes of the January 28, 2020 meeting were approved as presented.

Old Business

1. Bag Tags – Motion made by Mary Fox, Seconded by Marg Elliott that bag tag system be rolled out starting August 1 and that by September 1 no garbage will be accepted without a tag. All in favor.
2. Tipping fees By-law 2020-11 was presented to committee members for their information.
3. Cameras at sites – felt they were no longer needed as there has been no illegal dumping at either site for the past few months, attendants will continue to monitor the situation and advise if there are any changes/updates.
4. Direction re enforcing bundling and compaction – Sheryl will contact Reid's to see if there are preferred materials to use for bundling the cardboard – or more specific - material to NOT use ie. Nylon rope or string etc.

New Business

1. Compactor Policy & Procedure presented to committee for review– James & Mike to review before approving. Baler is not being used until policy approved & possible cement pad made

2. Community education – material will be developed over time with input from James, Mike and the committee to include such information as fees for disposal, lifespan of site, importance of compacting & sorting. Admin will then include information on website, Facebook, mail out flyer/newsletter etc.
3. Trackloader – no longer an issue

Motions to be made to Council

Motion made by Glenn and seconded by Mary –

For Council to authorize waste site attendants, James & Mike, to stay after hours when necessary and appropriate to burn the burn piles as opposed to paying to ship those materials.

As there is an accumulation of materials due to the extended total burn ban – the initial request is for a maximum of 4 hours then moving forward it would be at the discretion of Glenn – Glenn would authorize the dates to ensure it is done on safe days ie no winds etc. As there is such an accumulation of material it cannot be burnt all at once to stay within the regulated 2m x 2m x2m

Motion made by Mary Fox and seconded by Glenn –

For Council to approve the purchase/costs to install a concrete pad and secure the roof over the baler/compactor. Quote received from Trotter's Carpentry June 20, 2020 in the amount of \$2017.05 for the above work.
