Old Business

1. Compactor – Set up on site. – Track loader is broken so they have not been able to make and move bales.
Motion made by Mary, seconded by Marg to request the purchase of 1 more tarp to completely enclose the compactor
2. Bag tags will be reviewed in 6 months
3. Bins for bulky waste – Sheryl contacted Reid's to see if it would be more cost effective to have Reid's leave a bin at the sites as opposed to the roads crew having to attend each time the bulky waste is picked up to load into bins on the truck, cost was going to be \$40. Per week to have a bin left so it will not be cost effective.
4. Mandate of the Committee – Motion made by Mary Fox and Seconded by Councilor Bridger to reserve extra time at the next meeting to go over in detail the draft by-law. Next months meeting will start at 10am to accommodate.

New Business

1. Grimsthorpe Site – Future Plans – Possible lease extension

Round table discussion on next steps for Grimsthorpe Site

Motion made by Mary and seconded by Marg to approach the MNR regarding extending the lease at the Grimsthorpe Site by 5 years as opposed to 10 since as of now the expected life span of the site is 7 years.

Sheryl to bring details of the lease for the Lennox and Addington site to the next meeting.

Review of waste site schedule will be discussed after Sheryl receives tracking slips from the waste site attendants.

Sheryl to find out how often Greenview does their assessments – annually?

2. Scrap Metal Contract – Committee members want to see bills/invoices for scrap metal before deciding if a contract should be created or a request for tender made.

3. OES wind up – Sheryl will contact EPRA – Electronic Products Recycling Association re contract.
