The Township of Tudor and Cashel has established a multi-year accessibility plan to prevent and remove barriers to accessibility and to meet requirements under the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act and the Integrated Accessibility Standards.

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Accessibility Accomplishments in 2020

General Accomplishments

Individualized Workplace Emergency Response Information process has been developed and is being reviewed again with employees in 2021.

Customer Service Accomplishments

Employees received training on Customer Service Standards in December 2020.

Information and Communications Accomplishments

Municipal website to be upgraded to meet 2.0 WCAG Compliance – this is scheduled to be completed in early 2021. Efforts being made to ensure all documentation is drafted and formatted in an Accessible manner.

Design of Public Spaces Accomplishments

Funding was applied for and received in 2020 to improve the accessibility of the Community Centre/Municipal Building by adding an additional access ramp, a power assisted accessible door as well as a roof covering over this portion of the building. Construction is expected to occur in 2021.

Next Steps

Although the Township of Tudor and Cashel does not meet the requirements to establish a municipal accessibility advisory committee we are committed to developing a relationship with a member of our community with a disability to consult with on recommendations on how to improve our services.
