**Road Work:**

**NEW BUSINESS**

**4.** Speed Limit South Steenburg Lake Rd – discussion on reducing the speed limit. Roads committee would like to see a recommendation from Greer Galloway during the road needs study that is currently underway as well as seek and opinion from Brian Anderson from Cowan re: liability.

**5.** Roads Needs Study – Greer Galloway is currently conducting the roads needs study. They have been requested to include only roads that the township owns and maintains – not Lanes or private roads. We have asked them to provide an opinion regarding safety concerns where the big culvert was replaced on South Steenburg. The committee would like prices on various signs such as “Keep Right”, “Hidden Entrance” etc - these will be provided for the next meeting.

## **ADDITION TO THE AGENDA**

6. Request for Hidden Entrance Sign at 2019 St. Ola Rd due to speeding and excessive ATV traffic – Glenn will investigate and evaluate
7. Request from a resident to have additional speed limit signs installed in Gunter – when exiting East Rd on to Weslemkoon they do not see the reduced speed limit sign, however it was noted that when approaching Gunter and driving to East Rd from the West end of Weslemkoon they would be made aware of the reduced speed there.
8. Committee would like to recommend to Council that a Community Safety Zone be established in Millbridge.
9. Next meeting's agenda will include topics/questions to be established prior to extending an invitation for Brian Anderson to attend a Roads Committee Meeting.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Renata Lane Turnaround – Discussion of altering the turnaround at Renata Lane – the adjoining land owner is being contacted to determine boundaries and seek permission if necessary to create a portion of the turnaround on his land (just immediately past the original turnaround location) The committee would like to ensure ownership of all land in the vicinity including the presumed unopened road allowance prior to proceeding with any work.
