Message from the Mayor:

Hello and a belated Happy New Year to all. Your Council has been hard at it from day one. We've had three marathon open meetings and accomplished many things that will help set us up for success over our four year term. I want to thank Deputy Mayor Bridger, and Councillors Holloway, Chadwick and Taylor for their engagement to date. And a special shout-out to Councillor Holloway for taking the lead on this first CCAC newsletter.

I'm pleased about the creation of ad-hoc committees to address the important issues relating to the impact of Short-term rentals in our community and maintenance policy around Class 6B roads. I look forward to the recommendations these committees will bring forward to council in due course. I also want to thank our Clerk, Nancy Carrol, for working with me in these early days. I have now found respect for the workload she faces every day.

On February 9th I had the opportunity to engage with our MPP, Ric Bresee along with the eight Mayors from North Hastings townships, their Deputy Mayors and Clerks. We have many similar operating and financial challenges. Collaboration and shared services was a main theme of the meeting.

On the issue of our storm damage claim, Mr. Ric Bresee made it very clear to me (and the other two townships present who have filed claims) that the provincial government has not made any changes to the program under which our claim was filed and he had no reason to believe that it would not be settled in due course. It's a big deal because at \$567,000 it represents 42% of our 2022 tax levy and if not settled favourably will have significant financial consequences for the taxpayers of Tudor & Cashel. Ric's words, and the fact that our Clerk has been fielding questions and providing more information to those processing our claim, gives me hope that there will be a favourable outcome to this claim.

Our next open Council meeting is set for Tuesday March 7th at 1:00. Drop in if you are able or watch it live on YouTube. I'll be there.

Council Hit the Ground Running

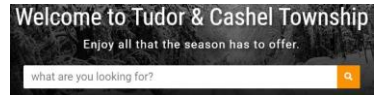
